

Reversible Cerebral Vasoconstriction Syndrome

Radiological Signs

"Sausage on string" sign on Angiography (GOLD STANDARD and resolves after 3 months)

Intraparenchymal hemorrhages on GRE

Convex Subarachnoid hemorrhage on FLAIR MRI.

Hyperintense dot sign (dilated cortical arterioles) on FLAIR MRI

Crescent shaped hyperintensity (vasogenic edema) on FLAIR MRI

Symmetric posterior Infarcts or widespread Ischemic zones in bilateral watershed regions on DWI
