Spontaneous

absence of dura around the nerve root sheaths

connective tissue disorders causing structural abnormalities such as osteophyte protrusions, and the herniation of the spinal disc.

Nude nerve root syndrome

Direct CSF-venous fistula

Iatrogenic

Lumbar Puncture

VP Shunt

Uterine growth lead to decreased CSF volume within the lumbar cistern.
