

Orthostatic Hypotension

↓ SBP 20
↓ DBP 10

Standing up/postural change + insufficient counter-regulation

Neurogenic Causes
< 20 BPM

Non-Neurogenic
> 20 BPM

Volume Depletion: Dehydration
Hemorrhage
Anemia
Hyperglycemia

Medication-induced orthostatic hypotension: alpha-blockers
diuretics
TCA
SSRI
beta-blockers
nitrates
